


## 01

### Check the included items

As soon as you open the package, check to see that all items are included. If anything is missing, please contact your dealer.




## 02

### Assemble the stand

#### Assembly procedure

- Loosen the hand knobs (A, two locations) and spread open the left and right legs of the stand as shown in the illustration.
- Loosen the hand knob of the snare pipe (B), and pull out the snare pipe toward the side of the performer.
- Adjust the pad mounts (C, four locations) as shown in the illustration.
- Attach the cymbal mounts (D, two locations) and hi-hat mount (E) as shown in the illustration.



\* The parts required for mounting the cymbals and the hi-hat are included in the TD-9KX attachment box.


#### Attach the hi-hat (CY-5)




#### Attach the crash cymbal (CY-8) and ride cymbal (CY-12R/C)




#### Attach the snare (PD-105) and toms (PD-85)









### Connect the pads to the sound module

\* To prevent the inadvertent disruption of power to your unit (should the plug be pulled out accidentally), and to avoid applying undue stress to the AC adaptor jack, anchor the power cord using the cord hook, as shown in the illustration.

#### Connection procedure


- Connect the cable to the TD-9 as shown in the illustration.
- Labels indicating the pad to be connected are attached to the cable. Make connections as shown in the illustration.
- Connect the AC adaptor, and fasten it to the cable hook as shown in the illustration to prevent it from being accidentally unplugged.

### Connect the AC adaptor and speakers

\* To prevent malfunction and/or damage to speakers or other devices, always turn down the volume, and turn off the power on all devices before making any connections.



## Detailed explanation of each part

### KD-8 (Kick)

\* Use a commercially available kick pedal.


#### 01 Making the settings



- Remove the screws attached to the reverse side of the KD-8's trigger.
- Pull out the stand in the direction indicated by the arrow until it is fully extended.
- Using any commercially available drum key, tighten the screws removed in Step 1 so that the stand is firmly secured.



#### 02 Attach the kick pedal

Position the beater so that it strikes the center of the head, then secure the kick pedal and KD-8 firmly in place.




#### 03 Adjusting the foot plate height

\* Depending on your kick pedal, it can be unstable when you attach it to the KD-8. Be sure to adjust the foot plate height so that the entire bottom surface of the pedal is attached to the floor.



- Loosen the stand's anchor bolts and remove the foot plate.
- Set the kick pedal so that the entire bottom surface is attached to the floor.



- In most cases, the stand becomes somewhat elevated. Tighten the anchor bolts securely there to fix the stand and foot plate.


#### NOTE

- Install the kick pedal securely.
- Take care not to pinch your fingers.
- The tips of the anchor bolts are sharp. Handle with care.
- When moving the KD-8, be sure to remove the screws and fold the stand. Transporting the KD-8 while it remains open may subject the stand to excessive strain and result in damage to the stand.
- Anti-skid tape is affixed to the foot plate. When transporting the KD-8, don't forget to pick up the foot plate.

#### 04 Adjusting the anchor bolts

When using the kick pedal on a drum mat or similar surface, adjust the anchor bolts so their tips protrude from the plate. Then, secure the pedal in place; this will make it easier to use the kick pedal.

However, when used on hard-surfaced flooring, the anchor bolts may damage the floor. Adjust the anchor bolts correctly.



\* The tips of the anchor bolts are sharp. Handle with care.

#### 05 When using a twin pedal

Position the two beaters equally apart from the center of the pad as shown in the figure at left. If one of the beater is further away from the center than the other, the sound from the further beater will be lower in volume, or will not sound as desired.

Using a twin pedal will result in lower sensitivity as compared to when a single pedal is used. Raise the sensitivity on the sound module.





### FD-8 component names




#### NOTE

- The tips of the anchor bolts are sharp. Handle with care.
- When using on hard-surfaced flooring, the anchor bolts may damage the floor. Do not attach the anchor bolts.
- To adjust the travel of the pedal, loosen the arm bolt.



- Continuous playing may cause dis-coloration of the pad, but this will not affect the pad's function.


## CY-8 (Crash cymbal)

### CY-8 component names




## CY-12R/C (Ride cymbal)




#### Fixing the cables (CY-12R/C)








#### NOTE

- Be sure to adjust the head tension of the PD-85 / PD-105 before use.
- Striking the head when the head tension is loose may damage the sensor and head.
- Do not apply excessive force to the sensor located below the center of the head of the PD-85 / PD-105. Doing so can interfere with accurate detection, and may damage it.
- Due to the nature of the materials used in the sensor of the PD-85 / PD-105, changes in room temperature may affect the sensitivity of the sensor.
- The rubber portion of the hoop is a consumable item that will undergo wear with use over time, depending on the number and strength of rim shots. Playing rim shots on the worn rubber portion may cause malfunctions. If this occurs, the hoop rubber should be replaced. Please contact Roland customer service regarding replacement of the hoop rubber.

### Head replacement procedure

- PD-85 replacement head (sold separately) : MH-8 mesh head
- PD-105 replacement head (sold separately) : MH-10 mesh head



If a lock bushing comes out of the frame while you're replacing the head, align the lock bushing's slots with the "+" shaped portion of the frame, and press it firmly into the frame.

## USING THE UNIT SAFELY

### ALWAYS OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING

- Do not attempt to repair the unit, or replace parts within it (except when this manual provides specific instructions directing you to do so). Refer all servicing to your retailer, the nearest Roland Service Center, or an authorized Roland distributor, as listed on the "Information."

#### CAUTION

- Never use or store the unit in places that are:
  - Subject to temperature extremes (e.g., direct sunlight in an enclosed vehicle, near a heating duct, on top of heat-generating equipment); or are
  - Damp (e.g., baths, washrooms, on wet floors); or are
  - Humid; or are
  - Exposed to rain; or are
  - Dusty; or are
  - Subject to high levels of vibration.

#### CAUTION

- This unit should be used only with a stand that is recommended by Roland.

#### CAUTION

- When using the unit with a stand recommended by Roland, the stand must be carefully placed so it is level and sure to remain stable. If not using a stand, you still need to make sure that any location you choose for placing the unit provides a level surface that will properly support the unit, and keep it from wobbling.

## IMPORTANT NOTES

### Placement

- Do not expose the unit to direct sunlight, place it near devices that radiate heat, leave it inside an enclosed vehicle, or otherwise subject it to temperature extremes. Excessive heat can deform or discolor the unit.
- Do not allow rubber, vinyl, or similar materials to remain on the unit for long periods of time. Such objects can discolor or otherwise harmfully affect the finish.

### Maintenance

- For everyday cleaning wipe the unit with a soft, dry cloth or one that has been slightly dampened with water. To remove stubborn dirt, use a cloth impregnated with a mild, non-abrasive detergent. Afterwards, be sure to wipe the unit thoroughly with a soft, dry cloth.
- Never use benzene, thinners, alcohol or solvents of any kind, to avoid the possibility of discoloration and/or deformation.

### Additional Precautions

- Use a reasonable amount of care when using the unit's buttons, sliders, or other controls; and when using its jacks and connectors. Rough handling can lead to malfunctions.
- When connecting / disconnecting all cables, grasp the connector itself—never pull on the cable. This way you will avoid causing shorts, or damage to the cable's internal elements.
- To avoid disturbing your neighbors, try to keep the unit's volume at reasonable levels. You may prefer to use headphones, so you do not need to be concerned about those around you (especially when it is late at night).
- This instrument is designed to minimize the extraneous sounds produced when it's played. However, since sound vibrations can be transmitted through floors and walls to a greater degree than expected, take care not to allow these sounds to become a nuisance to neighbors, especially when performing at night and when using headphones.
- Some connection cables contain resistors. Do not use cables that incorporate resistors for connecting to this unit. The use of such cables can cause the sound level to be extremely low, or impossible to hear. For information on cable specifications, contact the manufacturer of the cable.
- The rubber portion of the striking surface is treated with a preservative to maintain its performance. With the passage of time, this preservative may appear on the surface as a white stain, or reveal how the pads were struck during product testing. This does not affect the performance or functionality of the product, and you may continue using it with confidence.
- Continuous playing may cause dis-coloration of the pad, but this will not affect the Pad's function.
- In the interest of product improvement, the specifications and/or appearance of this unit may subject to change without prior notice.
